


WELCOME TO EINDHOVEN!

Our Fan zone

Your first stop in Eindhoven should be our Fan zone! You'll find this meeting point at Vibes Urban Sport's & Event Centre (Lardinoisstraat 8). You can meet up with other Napoli fans and enjoy something to eat and to drink.

Our Fan zone opens its doors at 12 noon on Tuesday, October 21st.





Dutch Design Week

Of course you are visiting our city to enjoy an exciting football match. But you are also more than welcome to discover the Dutch Design Week.

From October 18 to 26, Northern Europe's largest design event returns to Eindhoven. During these days Eindhoven transforms into a design hotspot. The Dutch Design Week is comparable to the equally renowned Salone di Mobile in Milan. Get ready for 100+ locations, 2.600 designers, and lots of exhibitions and activities.

Parking & Mobility

Most of you will travel to Eindhoven by public transport. Fans travelling by cars are advised to carpool as much as possible. Because of the Dutch Design Week, finding a parking spot can be a challenge. Parking is available at the regular/public parking facilities in the city. The parking garage 'Langs het spoor' is recommended (Navi: Philitelaan 71 Eindhoven). But note that it is extra busy, since it is located at the heart of the Dutch Design Week.

Buses and minivans can park for free at the Achtseweg Zuid at the matchday .

The trainstation is in the city center within walking distance of the stadium. Please note that it is almost impossible to catch a train (to Amsterdam) after the match. Be well informed with the correct timetable.

Safety & Security

With so many visitors in the city — football fans and design enthusiasts — it is important to ensure that everyone can safely enjoy all the activities.

To maintain smooth traffic flow, for example, detours have been planned. In addition, the mayor of Eindhoven has decided to designate a security risk area around the PSV-Napoli match. Within this security risk area, the police are authorized to carry out preventive searches. Please make sure that you always have your valid ticket and ID at hand.

The area includes the city center of Eindhoven, the surroundings of the stadium, and several access roads to the city center. The measure will be in effect from Monday, October 20 at 5:00 PM until Wednesday, October 22 at 3:00 AM. PSV is also taking additional measures in and around the stadium for this Champions League match.
